Welcome to the Saale–Unstrut Region

Situated on the banks of the rivers Saale and Unstrut between Leipzig and Weimar, and nestling as it does in a landscape shaped by high medieval feudal culture and the mild climate, there is plenty to discover in this region: fine wines, sensational archaeological finds such as the Nebra Sky Disc, a wide variety of active pastimes and impressive historical buildings along the Romanesque Road.

The perfectly shaped interior of Naumburg Cathedral, which is overwhelming in its impressive uniformity, transports you to the Middle Ages in a way that is seldom experienced. The magnum opus of the unknown sculptor and architect, the Naumburg Master, can be found in the west choir: a unique cycle of founding figures that presents a lively illustration of the people of his time, and which every year casts a spell over hundreds of thousands of visitors.

Get ready for the highpoint of the year! From 29th June to 2nd November 2011 the state exhibition will for the first time dedicate a wide-ranging presentation to the works of the Naumburg Master. Examples of sculpture in the cathedral and the "Schlösschen" [small castle] on the marketplace will bring to light the Naumburg Master's roots in French cathedral art.

This year's theme for Saxony Anhalt, "Heartbreakers. A Rendezvous with Culture – Saxony Anhalt's Beautiful Towns" provides the perfect excuse for you to take advantage of the many and varied opportunities for discovering the historic towns along the Saale, Unstrut and White Elster rivers.

The Naumburg Master – Sculptor and Architect in the Europe of Cathedrals

The city of Naumburg and Naumburg Cathedral are delighted to welcome you to the Saxony Anhalt State Exhibition 2011.

Exhibition – A journey back in time with the „Naumburger Master“ through Europe's cathedrals

From 29th June to 2nd November 2011 Naumburg will be presenting a once-in-a-century cultural event. The Saxony Anhalt State Exhibition is dedicated to one of the most significant European sculptors of the Gothic period, the artist known as the Naumburg Master. Inspired by French cathedral architecture, the Master reached Naumburg after a period in Mainz. Little is known about the artist whose enigmatic statue in the west choir of Naumburg Cathedral of the founding figure, Uta von Ballenstedt, has drawn people under its spell for centuries. Those who are lucky enough to see his sculptures are inevitably attracted by the singular expressiveness and emotion of his captivating works. For the first time, visitors to the State Exhibition will be given the opportunity to experience a large number of the works of art that have been linked to the Naumburg Master all in one place. Top quality loan items from France and throughout Europe (including from the Louvre in Paris), illustrate the sculptures, treasury art and examples of rare glass painting and book illuminations, and offer visitors unique insights into the cultural and artistic exchange of the High Middle Ages in Europe.

Exhibition sites – a tour around Naumburg's historic old town

The exhibition encompasses several locations in Naumburg's cathedral precinct and civic town. In the "Schlösschen" (small castle) on the marketplace the visitor is first of all introduced to the fascinating "world of Gothic cathedrals" and their architects.

Monumental exhibition pieces in the **Cathedral of St. Peter and St. Paul**, in the Church of St. Mary and the cathedral cloisters chart the "path and works of the Naumburg Master" and his workshop. Starting from the stations before and after Naumburg – Mainz and Meissen – the visitor will find out all about the emergence of the "Naumburg" workshops in Reims, Noyon, Coucy and Metz. In the third part of the exhibition in the **city museum "Hohe Lilie"**, visitors can experience the contemporary historical discourse surrounding the founding figures.

A special highlight that awaits the guest is the recultivated **Naumburg cathedral garden**. The garden, which previously was closed to the public, is an inviting place to walk, reflect and enjoy a cup of coffee. In the "Naumburg Master's garden" the visitor will see many of the plants that the famous sculptor depicted in such remarkably lifelike fashion in his friezes, capitals and keystones on the western rood screen and in the west choir. Last but not least, the **Chapel of the Aegidian Curia** and **St. John's Chapel in the cathedral cemetery** can also be visited.

Companion locations – an excursion in the Saale-Unstrut Region

The companion locations in the Saale-Unstrut region of **Merseburg**, **Zeitz**, **Schulpforte**, **Freyburg**, **Bad Kösen** (**Rudelsburg** and **Saaleck castles**) and **Schönburg**, with their important listed buildings and medieval works of art, are well worth a visit. The companion locations are closely connected to the history of the cathedral, its chapter and the bishops of Naumburg. The visitor will also encounter the works of the Naumburg Master in the charming, vine-clad cultural landscape around Naumburg.

Merseburg



The castle and cathedral, which together dominate the town, contain numerous works of art for the visitor to marvel at. The tomb figure of the knight, Hermann von Hagen, was created for Merseburg Cathedral by the Naumburg Master. Experience the 13th century through the eyes of the Naumburg Master on a guided tour.

In search of the Naumburg Master, and the 13th century life of the canons in Merseburg's cathedral chapter

Duration: 90-minute cathedral and chapter house tour

Tour content: History of the building – major renovation in 13th century – the oldest window in Merseburg Cathedral – glass pendants, choir screens, triumphal crucifix, crossing with the tomb of Rudolf of Swabia – the organ: queen of instruments – including the possibility of trying out the keyboard – visit to the chapter house and the Baroque terraced garden incl. issuing of a small certificate.

Schulpforte



Pforta Abbey is a former Cistercian monastery in the Naumburg district of Schulpforte, which has housed a state school for gifted children since 1543. The group of buildings, which covers an area of around 16 hectares in all, is still enclosed today by the historic abbey walls. The abbey church, with its original structural forms, is an outstanding example of 13th century Cistercian architecture. Influenced by the works of the Naumburg Master, the east choir, construction of which began in 1251, was modelled on the west choir in Naumburg.

Tour content: Guided tour through the historic buildings of the former abbey, overview of the history of the abbey and school, special features of Cistercian architecture taking the abbey church as an example with special focus on the High Gothic choir.

Freyburg



The Freyburg Masters

Just eight kilometres to the north of Naumburg, the imposing Neuenburg castle towers over the small winegrowing town of Freyburg. The sister castle to the Wartburg was established in 1090 by the Thuringian count, Ludwig the Leaper, and was extended to magnificent effect under the landgraves of Thuringia. The two storey chapel, which was built around 1170/1175, is an architectural jewel with unusual decoration that the famous Prussian preservationist, Ferdinand von Quast, described as "perhaps the most accomplished of all the ornamentation that we possess from the Middle Ages".

The Church of St. Mary was certainly founded in around 1210/1230 by Landgrave Ludwig IV of Thuringia and his wife, Elisabeth, who was later canonized. Despite subsequent alterations, the original late Romanesque shape is still clearly evident. The church's design shows many similarities to Naumburg Cathedral. But who were the architects? Perhaps they left their likenesses behind in the central tower of the church and the splendid central support of the Neuenburg's upper chapel – the Freyburg Masters!

Make sure to visit this gem on a comprehensive journey of discovery among the vineyards of the Unstrut. Both independent and [by arrangement] guided tours can be undertaken.

Zeitz



The episcopal see that was founded in the year 968 by Otto the Great was moved to Naumburg in 1028. For almost two hundred years the churches in Naumburg and Zeitz argued over the right to use the titles of cathedral church and chapter. "The Old Cathedral Church and the New Collegiate Monastery" is a special exhibition dedicated to the eventful history of the dioceses and displays rare documents. With the collections of the last bishop of Naumburg, Julius Pflug (1499–1564), the Moritzburg castle monastery library possesses a unique treasure trove of books, including rare editions of Reformation writings by Martin Luther and Philipp Melanchthon.

The Old Cathedral Church and the New Collegiate Monastery

Duration: 60 minutes

Tour content: Was the Naumburg Master familiar with the old cathedral church in Zeitz? This guided tour takes visitors through the "Old Cathedral Church and New Collegiate Monastery" exhibition (opening times: 9.8. to 2.11.2011 daily 10 am – 6 pm) and afterwards through the rooms of Zeitz's abbey library. The exhibition displays unique, in some cases never before exhibited, items from the documentary heritage of Zeitz's Collegiate Church, which – looking at the issue from the Zeitz point of view – deal in particular with the long battle for supremacy in the diocese.

Schönburg



In the Middle Ages, the castle with its imposing circular tower was an important possession of the bishops of Naumburg. Of the original 12th and 13th century structure, wall remains, the keep and the court house of the bishops of Naumburg can all still be seen. Nowadays, the "Alte Försterei", which dates from 1539, houses the castle restaurant.

Special exhibition in the glasshouse about the eventful history of Schönburg castle from its beginnings until the Reformation.

Rudelsburg and Saaleck Castles



High above the Saale valley, the picturesque ruins and popular attractions of Saaleck and Rudelsburg castles remind us of the power and importance of the bishops of Naumburg.

The ruins of the hilltop castle of Rudelsburg are situated on the eastern bank of the Saale on a rocky shell limestone ridge about 85 metres above the river. It was erected as a fortress by the bishops of Naumburg in the High Middle Ages to safeguard trading routes such as the Via Regia and the bridge over the Saale in Bad Kösen. Saaleck Castle is just a few hundred metres upriver from Rudelsburg. Visitors who climb the west tower after touring the exhibition will be rewarded by a magnificent view of the Saale valley.

Ever-changing exhibitions and tours plus numerous restaurants (Rudelsburg, Rittergut Kreipitzsch and Berggaststätte Himmelreich) entice visitors to a region of charming landscapes and fascinating history.
